Participants:	The <i>Forum's</i> Steering Committee welcomes up to 48 leading lawyers who specialize in cross-border litigation matters. Participants are personally selected based on their experience and specialization in this area.
Our Format:	The <i>Forum</i> is an annual discussion-based meeting. Participants are personally selected by Members of the Steering Committee. The Committee also formulate the Agenda of topics to be discussed during the interactive Sessions. The Chatham House Rule governs all discussion, allowing a free flow of ideas and insights. This coupled with the absence of traditional presentations and lengthy speeches, enriches the discussion.
Program Atmosphere:	This is an intense day-and-a-half of meetings. The 6, 80-minute Sessions, moderated by Members of the Steering Committee, are a collaborative opportunity for a deep dive within complex issues. A hollow square, for a maximum of 48 people, provides a level playing field. The receptions and dinners provide an ideal environment for referrals and networking. Therefore, this is not a "holiday" type program and as such, significant others or guests do not participate in the Sessions or attend any of the cocktail receptions or meals.
CLE / CPD Accreditation:	Upon request, a certificate of attendance outlining participatory hours may be issued. Hours are subject to jurisdictional approvals and requirements. The process takes approximately 8 weeks after the Forum concludes.
Location & Venue:	The <i>Forum</i> is being held Sunday, June 2nd - Tuesday, June 4th, 2024, at The Salamander Resort & Spa in Middleburg, VA. Participation Fee:	Your participation fee includes two nights' accommodation, all meals and wine with dinner, meeting Sessions, and online access to materials, and all taxes and gratuities. The fee is \$4,155 USD . Participants are expected to stay at The Salamander Resort & Spa during the <i>Forum</i> , as the interplay within the group is an important component. <i>Please note:</i> The <i>Forum</i> is limited to 48 participants, places are reserved on a <i>first-come, first-served basis</i> . The invitation was issued to you personally and is not transferable. Your place will be confirmed upon receipt of payment.
